

«European and International Law» (32 ECTS)

Description

European and international law are constantly gaining in importance in Swiss law. This is best exemplified by the «Bilateral Agreements» between Switzerland and the European Union. In the framework of the profile «European and International Law» students can choose from a wide range of courses and thereby set their own points of emphasis. Basic topics as well as questions of current interest are covered and contextualized, albeit with a special emphasis on European law.

This profile is aimed at students who have a special interest in the international and European dimensions of Swiss legal practice.

Requirements

Those students who wish to qualify for the profile «European and International Law» must earn at least 32 ECTS-points through different achievements (intensive block and semester courses, Master thesis, research thesis) which count towards this profile.
