

## «Family and Society» (32 ECTS)

### Description

The profile «Family and Society» gives an intra- and interdisciplinary education in the areas of family, partnership and children. Personal and financial aspects will be dealt with, for which reason not only family law, but also inheritance and social law are included. In addition, mediatory themes as well as alternative litigation methods will be dealt with.

This Profile is aimed at students with the following career goals: Lawyer specialising in Family Law, working for a guardianship authority, for a family agency, youth agency or social agency. Certain aspects of the Profile also serve as a preparation as notary public.

### Requirements

Those aiming for the profile «Family and Society» must earn at least 32 ECTS-points through block and semester courses, Master's thesis, and research thesis, which count for this profile.
