

## Summer Academies

A range of summer courses is offered by Swiss and foreign universities. These courses usually last two to three weeks and cover subjects such as European Law, International Public Law, Humanitarian Law, Tax Law, Legal Terminology etc. Conditions of admission, registration deadlines, tuition fees, length and form of the summer schools vary according to the institutions organising them. In general, summer school is also open to students who do not yet hold an academic degree. The faculty's Erasmus and International Relations Office has information concerning current summer academies.
