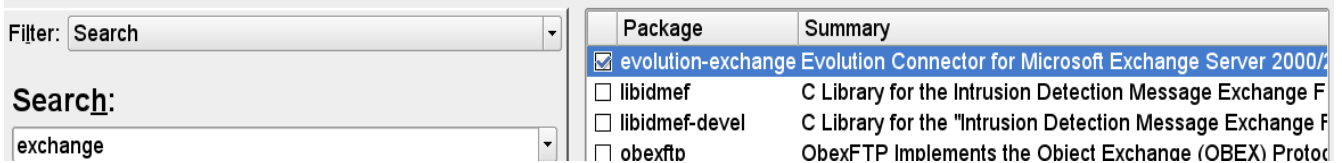


Linux: Configuration of Evolution with Exchange Server

First of all, check if the package `evolution-exchange` has been installed:



Check the following options:

Add the ldap server for access to Active Directory.

Those 2 options are very important: select the "Outbox" and the "Sent Items" on the EXCHANGE server and not "On This Computer".
