WHAT

Language and Emotions

What is the connection between language and emotions? How do our emotions influence language processing? How does language help us understand emotional states and responses? These and many other questions about the interface between language and emotions will be discussed in this two-day SwissUniversities workshop on Language and Emotions, presented at the University of Fribourg.

The workshop will take an interdisciplinary approach blending linguistics, psychology and cognitive sciences. It will touch upon the theoretical issues in the interplay between emotions and language, looking at how emotions affect language comprehension; What is the role of embodiment in explaining these interactions? What can we find out about language system by studying emotions? Both invited speakers will use their own expertise in the second part of this workshop to introduce and discuss the newest empirical designs used in the cognitive sciences of emotions and to investigate the language of emotions. A wide range of experimental paradigms will be presented and explained by our two international scholars and people will be encouraged to discuss their own research and designs.

In sum, this workshop will give you an insight into state-of-the-art theoretical and empirical trends in the study of emotions and embodiment and how they influence language processes. Finally ample space will be devoted to the discussion of practical and theoretical questions raised by participants.
