The lecturer will teach a course on International Environmental Law in English at Master's level (4th and 5th year of study). The course will be held over a period of 11 weeks at a rate of three hours per week. The course will take place every two years in the spring semester.

The lecturer must hold a doctorate in law and (academic or practical) experience in international environmental law. Teaching experience at university level is desirable.

The start date is 1st February 2025.
