

FIDEM-SIEPM Scholarship for the European Diploma in Medieval Studies (DEEM) 2023-2024

The 'Fédération Internationale des Instituts d'Études Médiévales' (FIDEM) and the 'Société Internationale pour l'Étude de la Philosophie Médiévale' (SIEPM) jointly provide a scholarship to students intending to enrol in the one-year graduate programme called Diplôme Européen d'Études Médiévales (DEEM), which offers 60 credits in medieval studies focusing on fundamental knowledge and skills in medieval Latin, palaeography, codicology, text editing, and others.

The scholarship consists in a 4000 Euros stipend and a tuition waiver. It supports talented students who lack the financial means to participate in the programme.

The awarding of the scholarship is contingent upon sufficient enrolment in the DEEM programme: a minimum of six participants is necessary for it to take place.

Selection Criteria

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- meeting the prerequisites for admission to the Diploma (see <https://fidemweb.org/deem-application/>)
- enrolment as in-class students in the complete annual programme (modular and personalised enrolments will not be considered)
- excellent academic records
- genuine financial need.

Students who are eligible to apply for the Erasmus programme are not considered. Applicants must declare their financial situation. Preference is given to students from low-income countries.

Scholarship recipients are selected through a competitive application process.

Application Process

Candidates must fill out the online form at <https://fidemweb.org/application-form-2023-2024/>. In the box at the very bottom, which asks for other relevant information, they must state that they wish to apply for the FIDEM-SIEPM scholarship.

Candidates must add a self-certification of their financial situation. It will be requested by an auto-reply e-mail upon submission of the online application, along with the request of other mandatory documents.

Application Timeline

The deadline for the submission of the completed application is September 15, 2023. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Applicants will be informed about the outcome of their application approximately two weeks after the deadline.

The scholarship will be paid in two instalments for the duration of the DEEM programme (approximately from mid-November to the end of May). The first instalment will be disbursed within 30 days of the start of the programme.
