

## Read&Publish agreement between Wiley and the University of Fribourg

## 1. Agreement and Conditions

Within the framework of the agreement between Wiley and the Consortium of the Swiss University Libraries, researchers at the University of Fribourg can publish in Open Access and free of charge **under the following conditions**:

- The date of **acceptance** of the article is after 01.05.2021.
- The national quota is not reached.
- The main author (**corresponding author**) is **affiliated** with the University of Fribourg at the time of submission, i.e. meets one of the following conditions¹:
  - He or she has an employment contract with the University of Fribourg at the time of submission;
  - He or she has a clinical title attributed by the University of Fribourg according to the Statutes of the University of Fribourg, article 30b (<u>link</u>);
  - He or she is Professor Emeritus of the University of Fribourg.
- The article has been submitted to one of the journals (<u>link</u>) included in the agreement regarding the publishing part. The agreement concerns hybrid journals but does include the fully Open Access journals of Wiley. Furthermore, roughly 6% of the hybrid journals are not part of this agreement.
- The type of the publication is one of the following: « primary research », « review articles qualify ». The types « letters », « editorials » for instance are not part of the agreement.

## 2. Process for the researcher

If the researcher fulfils the above-mentioned conditions, he or she may benefit from the agreement in the following way:

- 1) Once the article has been accepted, the corresponding author receives an e-mail to finalize the publication.
- 2) He/She selects his/her affiliation
- 3) He/She may then choose the option « Make my article open access ».
- 4) He/She enters his/her contact details and submits his/her request.

NB: in all contacts with Wiley, researchers are advised to use their institutional email address (@unifr.ch).
