ELIGIBLE COSTS

The **fellowship** provides for *living and research costs* at the place of stay (based on the local cost of living), *including* participation fees in scientific events, if any.

The fellowship amount is increased for beneficiaries accompanied by their partner, *provided the criteria are met* (see Guidelines art. 5 al. 2 c) and art. 11 al. 2).

ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCES

Depending on the beneficiary's personal situation (see Guidelines), the following contributions may also be granted:

- a grant towards **tuition fees** at the host institution, provided proof that exemption from these fees has been refused (max. 5'000/year);
- a contribution to **essential research costs** at the host institution, provided proof that the host institution does not offer such facilities (max. 1'000/semester);
- a **child allowance**, according to the standards in force at the University of Fribourg (any child allowances paid by third parties are deducted).
- A contribution towards the **travel costs for accompanying person(s)**, in accordance with Guidelines art. 12 al. 1 b).
