	Unterkunft	The University offers different kinds of accommodation that certainly all have their pros and cons. I lived at Mørkvedlia student park which is located in walking distance from the University. I had my own room with bathroom and shared the common kitchen with 14 other students.
	Kosten	Similar to Switzerland, however some things like for example alcohol are much more expensive due to the Norwegian tax system.
