Course Options

Students are presented with two tracks, each offering a distinct set of course options. Each track consists of two courses, with each course worth 3 credits (6 credits = 10 ECTS). The actual teaching hours for each course are 45 hours. Students can take both courses in the track they choose or 1 course only.



Track 1

The “Business in Korean perspective” track offers students a chance to learn about the Korean economy, business practices, and global marketing management, in the context of the Asian market. Through lectures and hands-on experiences, students will gain a comprehensive understanding of the unique challenges and opportunities facing Korean and other Asian businesses in the global marketplace, and explore a special topic in global business.

Track 2

The “Korean Studies” track is perfect for those who are interested in Korean culture, including recent pop culture and history. Through a combination of lectures and hands-on experiences, students will gain a comprehensive understanding of the unique aspects of Korean culture and society, with a special focus on mass media and popular culture. The program offers a range of special topics in Korean studies, such as Korean Tradition and Culture, Korean History, and Mass Media and Popular culture in Korea, which provide students with a deeper appreciation of the country's contemporary cultural landscape.

Application Process

Students must complete the following **two-step application process**.

Please ensure that **Step 1 is completed before proceeding to Step 2**.

While the application procedure is the same for all students, **program fees are determined by the student's home university partnership status (institution type) and application date**.

→ Create your UOS SISS ID to activate your personal dashboard.



→ During Step 1, students must select the **correct institution type to receive the appropriate partner discount**. If they are unsure about their home university's partnership status with UOS, they are advised to confirm with their home university's international office before proceeding.

Step 2: [Complete Application](#)

→ Log in to your dashboard, upload required documents, and submit the application form.

→ To qualify for the **Early Bird Discount**, students must complete **both Step 1 and Step 2 by May 15**.

Refund Policy

Please be advised that all refund requests must be submitted in writing to our Seoul International Summer School team. The registration fee is non-refundable. Refunds will be processed within 3-4 weeks of receipt of a valid request.

For tuition refunds, the following policies apply:

- If a student withdraws by June 24, 2026, which is one week prior to the start of the program, the tuition will be refunded less any commission fees or bank transaction charges.
- 50% of the tuition fee will be refundable for the request from June 25 to 30, 2026, before the start of the program, less any commission fees or bank transaction charges.
- From the official start of the program, July 1, 2026, no refund will be available.
- A written notice of withdrawal must be made to the office before the deadlines stated above in order to receive the refund.
