<b>Green Travel</b>			
if students travel by train or bus for their onward or/and return journey they receive additional CHF 100.- after presenting the ticket			
Currency translation rate: CHF 100.- is around EUR 101.-			
Students who receive from their home university an <b>Erasmus+ mobility grant</b> for their stay at the University of Fribourg are not eligible for the SEMP grant			

#### Calculation of the grant amount

- Students (for example doctoral students) who want to spend less than 3 months at the University of Fribourg, have to be **at least during 60 days in Fribourg** and will receive the grant for 3 and a half months → CHF 1430.- / CHF 1640.-
- These amounts and conditions have been defined by the Swiss government for all Swiss universities.
- For a traineeship the grant is calculated according the actual duration of the traineeship in days:  $CHF 440 \div 30 \times \text{days}$
