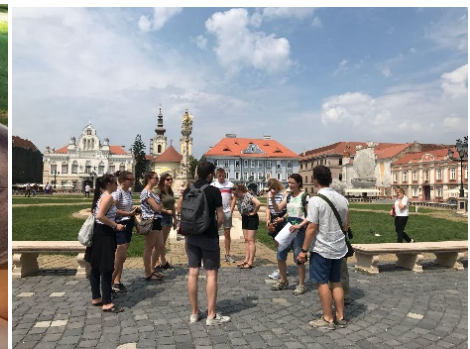

History: The ISSSA Program is offered to UniFR and WUT STUDENTS in the frame of the Convention 80099/07.10.2000 between West University of Timisoara and University of Fribourg. This summer school is the 7th edition of a series that began in Valais in 2012 and it was followed in 2013, 2015 and 2018 in Romania, and in 2014 and 2019 in Switzerland. Its purpose is to enable social sciences students from Switzerland and Romania to exchange experiences and achieve transversal competences during a one-week fieldwork stage in an international environment.

Participants: 20 students from UniFR and WUT and teachers, researchers, academic staff from the West University of Timisoara (Romania), University of Fribourg (Switzerland) and Norwegian University of Science and Technology (Norway).

The theoretical frame of this edition is Urban Anthropology. Students will be provided with an observation grid, guidelines and a training on the first day of the summer school. The fieldwork will be carried out by teams of 4-5 students. After short discussions in the mornings, each team will make observations during the day on their own, and will take note of them. We will meet each evening to sum up the activities and



exchange our observations. After reporting students will receive a mutually recognized certificate of

attendance.
