

Telders International Law Moot Court Competition



With a tradition of more than 40 years, the Telders International Law Moot Court Competition brings together students from the most prestigious law schools in Europe. The international round will be taking place at the *Faculty Campus The Hague of Leiden University* and in the *Peace Palace* in The Hague with the participation of judges from the International Court of Justice.

The teams are faced with a case regarding a dispute between two fictitious states. The students have to defend both states in writing and through oral pleadings.

Schedule:

November 2022:

Start of the written phase.

February-March 2023:

Submission of the written pleadings.

March-May 2023:

Preparation of the oral pleadings and possibly national qualification round.

June 2023:

Final International Round in the Hague in front of ICJ judges, judges from the Iran-United States Claims Tribunal, lawyers and law professors.

1st September 2022: APPLICATION DEADLINE

ECTS recognition:

10 ECTS points:

- **5 ECTS points** for drafting the applicant's and respondent's written memorials can be recognized as a (pro-)seminary paper or as special credits
- **5 ECTS points** for the preparation of the oral pleadings and the attendance of at least one oral phase of the competition can be recognized as special credits within the MLaw program

Please note: Participation in both phases is mandatory

- Due to the overlapping of the oral phase with the second examination session in Fribourg, the Moot Court is particularly addressed to Master students.
