



Jean-Pictet Competition 2015/2016

In International Humanitarian Law

The Jean-Pictet Competition is a simulation-based legal competition on international humanitarian law. About 50 teams consisting of three students are required to apply their legal skills in a simulated armed conflict environment, taking on different roles such as of the ICRC, military staff, government officials, NGOs or rebels. The preparatory work for the Competition will begin in the fall term 2015. The Competition will take place **from 19 to 26 March 2016 in Evian-les-Bains (France)**.

Why take part in the Competition?

- Training on the application of IHL in the presence of experts (jury and tutors);
- Personal development through experience of team work, presentation and speaking techniques, communication, stress management, ...;
- Meeting students from all over the world;
- An important asset in a CV for students wishing to work in the field of IHL, international solidarity, international criminal law and refugee law.
