New Program at the Law Faculty: Master of Laws in Cross-Cultural Business Practice

In 2009, the new Master's Program of the University of Fribourg welcomed students from every continent (Australia, Brazil, Cameroon, Canada, China, Italy, Peru, Russia, Spain, and the United States). Most of these students were young lawyers looking to specialize in international business practice. More than 50 instructors, known for their areas of expertise, came from all over the world to teach in the Program, which is offered jointly by the Law Faculties of the Universities of Bern and Neuchâtel. The uniqueness of the Program stems from its global and interdisciplinary approach to business law.

The Program is exclusive to jurists (MLaw) seeking to specialize in international business law in an international and multicultural environment. **Five spots** are reserved with special conditions for students of the of the University de Fribourg. Courses are taught in English and require English language proficiency. The preparation of a Master's Thesis is a requirement for the LL.M.

Last year, 90% of our graduates were offered internships or jobs with multinationals, law firms and international organizations. Students were supported in all aspects of their applications to these institutions by the directors of the Program.
