The Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (SoTL) considers university lecturers as experts in teaching, who engage in applied research on their teaching practice.

Teaching as a subject of research

The SoTL approach enables you to analyse your teaching practice through a scientific process. The aim is to critically and systematically examine an aspect of your teaching to support student learning, drawing on theoretical frameworks and empirical data. The process is concluded by sharing experiences within the academic community and/or disseminating results through presentations (conferences) or publications (pedagogical journals).
